- 12 persons were in attendance.
  - Visitor - Tim Bowles(?) from Carlisle (interested in Ultra-lights and wants to take lessons from Tom Harry)
- Minutes from March 2010 meeting were read and approved.
- Treasurer's Report was read and approved showing a balance of \$1987.02
- Prepare for the Father's Day Fly-In
  - Planning Committee meeting with other Clubs will be at the Lincoln Diner this Saturday in Gettysburg
  - NEW ACTIVITY – Gentleman in York Making Training Video's – started by making a video showing how to fly through special flight zone in DC – He will be at the Father's Day Fly-In on Saturday, June 19, 2010 to give a briefing - [www.aviationsafetyvideos.com](http://www.aviationsafetyvideos.com)
  - John Shreve indicated that most of the persons who were scheduled for last year's event will be there this year (PA Triumph Assoc. and maybe an antique truck and Stanley Steamer)
  - John also told us that they would be outsourcing the food this year but that the family would still be involved (helping out) – Food and service to be the same as usual and John will be serving the Prime Rib (hopefully they will have the same menu as before) – Crosswinds Café will be opened between 9:00am and 3:00 – 4:00pm
  - Skydivers haven't been contacted but are expected to be there
  - Color Guard (Civil Air Patrol) from York will be doing the honors this year
  - Tent for WWII Vets will be available for anyone who may visit the Fly-In (High Flyer's)
  - Vendors have not yet been contacted, however Roger brought up that New Hope Ministries is interested in being there and doing games (for a cost) for kids (this was approved by the Club – New Hope Ministries will also have Coffee and baked goods in the morning (0600hrs – 0800hrs) for sale and sell soda during the movie in the evenings
  - Med-Vac Unit will be there and we will need a 50ft clearance for them to park (between 1200hrs and 1400hrs) – Use Grass Marking Paint to outline spot
  - Roger will have the movies (planning on showing Radio Flyer and another movie that is currently undetermined) and Denny will have the sound system again this year
  - Jim will get additional signs this year – Paul asked if we needed more signs – Jim said they wanted bigger signs with arrows etc. – Paul will get signs made and Club will contribute \$50.00 towards this service (approved by Club to pay this amount) – about 2 dozen needed – Parking lot signs are adequate so just need signs for directing people/traffic to the field

- Jim will take care of Publicity this year by contacting News Media (York Dispatch)
- T-Shirts and Hats will be purchased (Mason Dixon T-Shirts and Hats) – Motion to purchase the minimum order for each was second and approved
- 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Father's Day Fly-In T-Shirts and Hats will be purchased to sell at the Fly-In – Minimum of 24 will be purchased – approved by members
- Paul will get the fire extinguishers readied for the Fly-In
- Need to get the gas pump repaired prior to the Fly-In
- The Club will offer Don Pratt's group of students to set up a fund raising area to try to get donations for their experimental plane they are building at Messiah College
- Don Pratt's students came to Paul's hanger to look at his engine and motor mounts
- John Shreve was awarded a 50 year plaque from the FAA for his over 3,000 hrs of flying – Congratulations John!
- John Shreve had his knee replaced and we wish him a speedy recovery
- Next Meeting will be on Thursday, May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2010.
