September 2009 Meeting

September 3, 2009

The covered-dish dinner was served at 1830hrs. Meeting called to order at 1902hrs.

- 11 persons were in attendance
- Minutes from August 2009 meeting were read and approved.
- Treasurer's Report was read with an ending balance of \$1,880.14.
- Christmas Party is at Ryan's in Hanover on Thursday December 10, 2009 at 7:00PM
- John Shreve was asked to give some input on the Father's day Fly-In
 - Despite the weather, he thought it was a very good weekend
 - He congratulated the township at Shreveport North (Washington Township) for all the amenities they have allowed him throughout the years
 - Talked about having a different look and feel (a Theme) for next years Father's Day Fly-In with the possibility of having a tractor parade honoring the Township, and those who make it up, with things they are familiar with
 - Talked about changing the way we conduct the food service due to not being able to determine the amount of food to purchase and have available for sale prior to knowing how many persons will be in attendance or due to weather conditions
 - John Marino suggested having something specific to discuss with the Township – Judy indicated that John Shreve had a specific rapport with the Township and he should go to them with these initiatives
 - Jerry suggested a committee (John Shreve, John Marino and Judy) be formed to discuss these issues and how to plan for next year
- Discussed the Labor Day Fly-In at Shreveport North during the Labor Day weekend.
 - Assembly of Aeroncas chairperson Robert Segio (Aeronca Club International – he is out of New York)
 - Hope is to be able to sponsor more fly-ins at Shreveport North with other aircraft
 - Due to the lateness of coordinating the fly-in, a low number of participants is expected
 - Reduced the expectations by only providing food service from the Cross Winds Café from 10:00am thru 4:00pm daily
 - Camping will be provided for a charge
 - Transportation to Baker's in Dillsburg will be provided for the evening meal
 - Roger offered his van (7 passenger) to transport passengers
 - Need signs for advertising the fly-in placed around the area (Jerry will take care of signs from Carlisle through Dillsburg, Franklintown etc.)
 - Fuel for this Fly-in will be provided – York or Carlisle airport would be closest to fly to for fuel – 4 persons needed to place tank on truck – generator needed to dispense fuel – need fire extinguishers
 - Need to register pilots/persons wanting to camp – persons needed to do this (Judy, Rick, Jerry and Roger)
 - Poker walk – Poker run will be played for \$10.00 per person – 4:00pm is the showdown
 - Best Aeronca – longest distance flown – ladies choice – best host Aeronca champ
 - Air Coupes will also be coming
- Nominations were taken for President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Events Coordinator and will be voted upon at the next meeting
